



APPLICATION FOR ORTHOPEDIC SURGERY ROTATION

Basic Criteria:

- Rotations are four weeks in duration and run from July-December of each year.
- Students must be in good standing and currently enrolled in a United States accredited/pre-accredited medical school.
- Students must be a MSIV medical student at the time of rotation.
- Students must have a **minimum** COMLEX 1 score of 610 OR Step 1 score of 245 in order to rotate.
- Applications will be considered starting January 1st of each given year. Applicants are considered on a rolling basis.
- Students will not be considered for a rotation until all application documents are received. A complete application consists of the following:
 - i. Letter of good standing.
 - ii. Proof of liability coverage from sponsoring institution.
 - iii. CV
 - iv. Immunization records including most recent TB/flu vaccination.
 - v. Unofficial board score report.
